## at a glance

### Dinner and Movie Night Pass

- Kids create their menu and kids set the table for an all new dining experience with friends & siblings
- Later kids watch an G-Rated movie of their choice and munch on popcorn at CHILD
- After the movie we role play, play a related game or create a book documenting the main theme of the movie and work on our comprehension and recall to build language
- Siblings take part in all aspects
- Friday & Saturday evenings from 6:30-9:30pm
- \$25.00 per child with special needs & \$15.00 per sibling/per hour
- Parents MUST go out and enjoy quality ME time

### Olympics

- Can't find a sports program that is non competitive and has skilled staff to teach your child sports play?
- CHILD now offers the the Olympic Club! An opportunity for kids to learn a variety of sports coached by a highly skilled team the fundamental of sports in a highly specialized way
- Coordination, flexibility, competence, physical activity, engagement, team work, motor planning, gross motor, social engagement, strength, attention and so much more...

### Homework Club

- Tired of fighting with your child to do homework?
- After school Homework Club is created to help kids get organized, get focussed and learn strategies to help them attack homework and be successful!
- Led by certified teachers, the program is geared for the child with special needs to help give them the power to take control and feel empowered in doing homework!
- 1 hour per week for 12 weeks \$420

### Community Social Skills

- Social skills for youth and teens works best out in the community.
- Learn to take public transit, shop, make purchases, order from a menu, converse with the public, keep track of time and money, make plans and learn how the world works.
- Groups are led by highly skilled therapists and run every Saturday
- Sessions occur every Saturday from 12:00-3:00
- \$35.00/hr +

### Center Social Skills

- An opportunity for kids not yet ready to go out in community, kids learn to relate to peers, communicate, learn pragmatic skills and are taught appropriate interpersonal skills to build meaningful relationships with others.
- Led by a skilled therapist, all groups run on Wednesday evenings for 1.5 hours
- Sessions run for 6-9 weeks. Sessions start at \$210.
